



2025-26 Bowl Ontario Tenpin YBC Doubles Tournament

DATES - subject to centre availability and are subject to change.

Average Date: Sunday, March 8, 2026, with a minimum 12 games.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Wednesday, March 11, 2026.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$90.00 per team (\$45.00 per youth bowler), (\$54.00 lineage, \$4.00 expenses, \$32.00 scholarship). Scholarships will be awarded 1 in 5 entries (teams).

FORMAT

The Tournament is open to all YBC bowlers and will consist of four (4) games. There are no divisions and teams can consist of female, male, or one (1) female & one (1) male. If, a Bantam bowler wants to bowl with a Junior or Senior, or a Junior with a Senior, because there are no divisions it will be allowed. Since, we may have some of our YBC leagues with 1 bowler in a division this makes it possible for them to bowl as well. This will be a handicap tournament based on 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220.

TOURNAMENT

All YBC bowlers having paid the entry fee will compete in the Bowl Ontario YBC Doubles Tournament to be held on Sunday March 22, 2026.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Bowl Ontario Tenpin YBC Doubles Tournament is open to all Youth bowlers who are registered with YBC and has bowled a minimum of 12 games as of March 8,2026.

2. YBC members are not permitted to enter this tournament more than once.
3. **Where Bowl Ontario Tenpin and / or Bowl Canada rules are not specified, the World Bowling (IBF) rules and regulations will be used. NOTE: 10-PIN BOWLING BALLS MUST MEET THE STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS AS SET FORTH BY WORLD BOWLING (IBF).**
4. **Bowling ball surface adjustments by hand are acceptable between games provided the adjustment procedure does not delay the bowler's next turn. Altering the surface of the bowling ball during a game is not allowed. (World Bowling rule 4.10)**
5. **Average sheets MUST accompany the entry form.**
6. All scores and / or averages will be checked and authenticated. Any falsification or misrepresentation of scores and / or averages, knowingly or unknowingly, will result in immediate disqualification of the team.
7. In the event of a tie or ties a one-game roll-off will be held with the highest score including handicap being declared the winner(s).
8. **PROTEST RULE** – Protests at any level of the competition shall be brought to the attention of the Tournament Director immediately upon the infraction. If, no satisfactory decision can be reached at this point, the protest is to be submitted in writing to Bowl Ontario Tenpin within forty-eight (48) hours of said tournament.
9. **DRESS RULE** – YBC Bowlers and Coaches must be attired in a YBC identified bowling shirt* or a shirt with a collar. Bottom portion is relaxed, no track / jogging pants, no jeans with rips, tears or holes and non-revealing shorts or skirts. It is intended that bowlers will be modest and respectful.

No hats, caps or any type of headgear, unless required for medical or religious reasons.

***NOTE: A YBC identified bowling shirt** shall be any garment, regardless of style, make, fabric or color that covers the upper portion of the body, providing one of the following graphics is screened or embroidered on the back or front of the shirt, and providing the shirt is issued and / or approved by the Bowling Centre: **THE OFFICIAL YBC LOGO or THE NAME OF THE BOWLING CENTRE or LEAGUE.**

Bowlers who fail to adhere to these rules may not be allowed to compete.

10. In case of dispute, the decision of the Tournament Director and / or Committee shall be final.
