



2026 Bowl Ontario Tenpin Adult Singles Tournament

DATES

Average Date: April 12, 2026, with a minimum 21 games.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Wednesday, April 15, 2026

Date: Sunday April 26, 2026

Time: 10:00 Registration and 11:00 Start

Location: Chatham Bowlerama, 100 Keil Drive, South, Chatham

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$50.00 per bowler, (\$29.00 lineage, \$2.00 expenses, \$19.00 Prize Fund).

Prizes awarded 1 in 5 entries.

OPTIONAL: Scratch Total Pinfall - \$10.00, with 1 in 5 entries paid out.

FORMAT

The Tournament is open to all bowlers including YBC bowlers 18 and over bowling in an Adult League in a Bowl Ontario Tenpin Centre and will consist of four (4) games. This will be a handicap tournament based on 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 240. The bowler(s) with the highest score including handicap will be declared the winner. Any YBC bowlers 18 and over that also bowl in an adult league will receive scholarship in place of cash.

TOURNAMENT

All Bowlers having paid the entry fee will compete in the Bowl Ontario Tenpin Singles Tournament to be held on Sunday April 26, 2026.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Bowl Ontario Tenpin Singles Tournament is open to all bowlers including YBC bowlers 18 and over bowling in an Adult League in a Bowl Ontario Tenpin Centre and having bowled a minimum of 21 games.
2. **Where Bowl Ontario Tenpin and / or Bowl Canada rules are not specified, the World Bowling (IBF) rules and regulations will be used. NOTE: 10-PIN BOWLING BALLS MUST MEET THE STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS AS SET FORTH BY WORLD BOWLING (IBF).**

3. **Bowling ball surface adjustments by hand are acceptable between games provided the adjustment procedure does not delay the bowler's next turn. Altering the surface of the bowling ball during a game is not allowed. (World Bowling rule 4.10)3**
4. **Bowlers MUST provide proof of average(s) with entry form for all leagues they bowl.**
5. All scores and / or averages will be checked and authenticated. Any falsification or misrepresentation of scores and / or averages, knowingly or unknowingly, will result in immediate disqualification of the team.
6. In the event of a tie or ties a one-game roll-off will be held with the highest score including handicap being declared the winner(s).
7. **PROTEST RULE** – Protests during the competition shall be brought to the attention of the Tournament Director immediately upon the infraction. If, no satisfactory decision can be reached at this point, the protest is to be submitted in writing to Bowl Ontario Tenpin within forty-eight (48) hours of said tournament.
8. **DRESS RULE** – **Bowlers must be attired in a bowling shirt or a shirt with a collar.** Bottom portion is relaxed, no track / jogging pants, no jeans with rips, tears or holes and non-revealing shorts or skirts. It is intended that bowlers will be modest and respectful.
9. Bowlers who fail to adhere to these rules may not be allowed to compete.
10. In case of dispute, the decision of the Tournament Director and / or Committee shall be final.
